Over-the-counter Insoles vs. Custom Orthotics

What's the difference?

Over-the-counter insoles are a great way to provide general arch support. They use a variety of different materials and arch types and offer an affordable way to provide immediate pain relief.

Custom foot orthotics are made from a 3D impression of your feet. They provide a more precise fit and are designed to correct foot function, alleviate pain, and improve body alignment.

Custom foot orthotics are adjustable which allow them to be fine-tuned as your needs change. They can also be designed to fit a broader range of shoe types including dress shoes, cleated shoes, skates, ski boots, and more.

Custom orthotics can help alleviate pain by correcting your foot function, off-loading painful joints, and improving your overall body alignment.








ALIGNED VS. MISALIGNED
